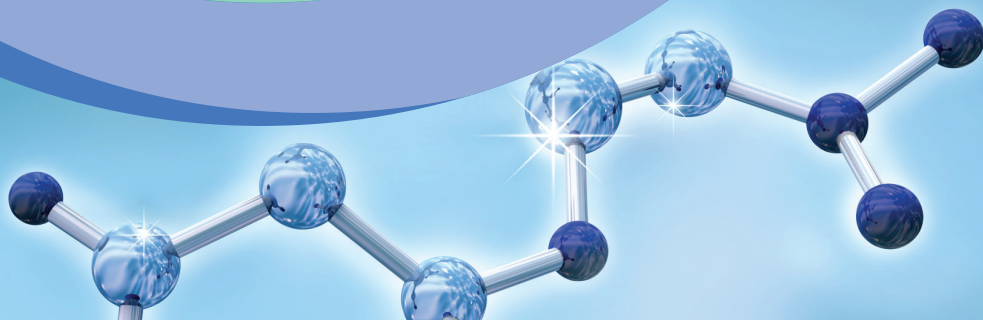

### • Arrival by car

*From the south*

Motorway exit Frankfurt-Süd (Frankfurt South) direction Stadtmitte (city center), Kennedyallee, via Alte Brücke, in the direction of Friedberg, on Kurt-Schumacher-Straße.

*From the north*

A66, Nordwestkreuz (north-west junction), Miguelallee in the direction of Fulda, take the 3rd large crossing right onto Nibelungenplatz in the direction of Stadtmitte (city center), straight ahead on the Friedberger Landstraße.

### • Arrival by train

All S-Bahn trains (city trains) at Frankfurt (Main) Central Station travelling in the direction of Frankfurt-Süd, Langen, Hanau, Darmstadt or Offenbach, as well as the U4 underground train in the direction of Seckbacher Landstraße and U5 underground train, travel to the Konstablerwache station. Approx. 2 minutes' walk to the hotel.

### • Arrival by plane

The S8 city train from the airport in the direction of Offenbach/Hanau travels direct to Konstablerwache station (approx. 15 minutes). Approx. 2 minutes' walk to the hotel.

### Parking

The hotel offers **150 parking** spaces in the underground garage: **€ 1,50 per 30 minutes, € 23 per day**

### Distances to major landmarks:

Nearest U-/S-Bahn (metro/city train) station: 0.1 km

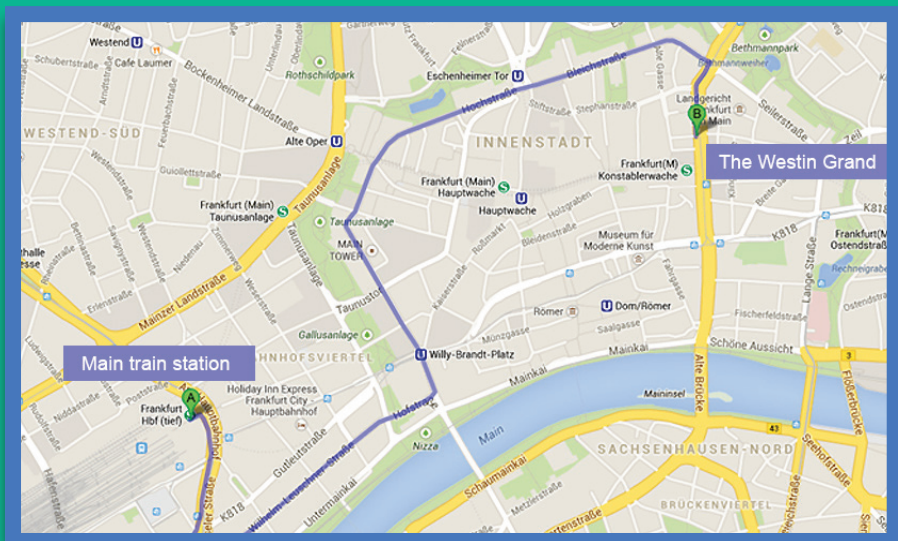
Nearest taxi rank: at the hotel
